**ORDER ON  
PARENT EDUCATION  
AND/OR CUSTODY MEDIATION**

This matter involves a dispute relating to child custody or visitation. In accordance with the Domestic Local Rules, the parties are required to complete Parent Education and participate in Custody Mediation, unless the Court waives the events.

There  has  has not been a showing of good cause which would allow, or require, the court to waive Parent Education.

There  has  has not been a showing of good cause which would allow, or require, the court to waive Custody Mediation.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Both parties are directed to complete Parent Education by the date already assigned or, if that date has passed, obtain a new date from the Parent Education provider.
- 2. Further proceedings, including discovery, in the custody or visitation dispute are stayed, and both parties are directed to attend mediation orientation on the date already assigned or, if that date has passed, obtain a new date from the Family Court office. Both parties are also directed to attend at least one mediation session.
- 3. For good cause shown,  Parent Education and/or  Custody Mediation is waived.
