The undersigned Chief District Court Judge for Judicial District 18 enters this Administrative Order pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 7A-146,


AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that Article 1, Section 18 of the North Carolina Constitution provides “All courts shall be open; every person for an injury done him in his lands, goods, person, or reputation shall have remedy by due course of law, and right and justice shall be administered without favor, denial or delay;”

ANIT FURTHER APPEARING THAT efficiency in our courts is of high priority, especially in light of the backlog of cases due to COVID-19 in Guilford County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. In Greensboro, Courtrooms 1A and 1B will be combined into courtroom 1B. The administrative courtroom 1B in Greensboro shall be open Monday thru Friday from 8:30 am until 12:30 pm. In High Point, administrative traffic court and 3B waiver court will be combined into courtroom 3B. The Courtroom 3B shall be open on Mondays and Fridays from 8:30 am until 12:30 pm.
2. This order is effective August 29, 2022.
