THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO ALL PERSONS IN THE GENERAL
PUBLIC ENTERING COURTHOUSE


- Please enter and leave the courtrooms quietly. No talking once inside the courtroom.
- Please maintain quiet in the courtrooms and corridor area.
- Persons arriving after court convenes may be required to wait until recess to enter any courtroom.
- Chewing gum, eating, drinking, or smoking is PROHIBITED in all courtrooms. No outside food or drink is permitted to be brought inside the courthouse without the express permission of court personnel.
- All persons should wear proper attire. No short pants, tank tops, bare feet, or clothing with vulgar language or pictures may be worn inside the courtrooms.
- Cell phones must be turned off or remain on "silent mode" and put away inside the courtrooms. If you are observed using your cell phone inside a courtroom, it will be confiscated by a bailiff and given to the Presiding Judge who will return the same at his/her discretion.
- Attorneys and court staff may enter and leave the courtrooms as necessary unless otherwise directed by the Presiding Judge.
- No person may videotape, audio record, or photograph any proceeding unless prior permission has been obtained from the Presiding Judge. Photography or videotaping the jury is strictly prohibited.
- The use of profanity inside the courtrooms and corridor areas are prohibited.
- At no time will a bondsman or officer enter a courtroom and retrieve a defendant being heard in court that day.

- All officers entering a courtroom shall be seated at the direction of the primary court bailiff.
- Counsel shall conduct themselves with dignity and respect while inside the courtrooms.
- Only authorized court officers and/or court personnel are allowed inside the bar.

ANY PERSONS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THESE RULES MAY BE HELD IN CONTEMPT OF COURT
