Revised Local Procedures and Form:

Motion and Order for Appropriate Relief (MAR)

Effective immediately, the following procedures and attached form shall be used for all written MARs in District Court:

- 1. All MARs shall be filed with the Clerk of Court.
- 2. All MARs shall be served by the Defendant on the District Attorney in the manner provided in G.S. 15A-951(b).
- 3. All MARs consented to, in writing, by the District Attorney may be submitted to any District Court Judge for signature.
- 4. All MARs not consented to by the District Attorney shall be noticed for hearing as follows:
 - a. The Defendant shall serve a filed copy of the MAR on the Chief District Court Judge (facsimile is acceptable).
 - b. The Chief District Court Judge's office shall notice for hearing, no sooner than 10 business days after the District Attorney has been served with the motion, and shall serve a copy on the District Attorney, Defendant/Defendant's attorney, and Clerk of Court via facsimile or U.S. postal service.
 - c. All MARs scheduled for hearing will be set at 11:00 a.m. in PC Court.

All previous Administrative Orders regarding MAR procedures and forms are hereby rescinded and no longer in effect.
